Free sessions with a generalist and AARP career coach, delivered in individual face-to-face or Skype sessions for a gamut of clients: returning to the workforce after an employment gap, changing careers, expats, and immigrants who are applying for entry-level to mid-level positions.

Career Finder's Club. A five-week program for people who need more structure in their job search. The next cohort will be using Edmodo - a collaborative platform to share resources and increase networking.

Training and Classes. Instruction on databases to create custom mailing lists; research industry and job search trends, finding executives, developing LinkedIn profiles. Laverne Clark, an award-winning librarian will demonstrate some of the resources.

Lunchtime and After-Work Seminars and Panel Discussions. Experts on topics like self-promotion, marketing, branding, social networking for general interest and special interest groups: people with disabilities, veterans, LGBT, performing artists, older adults.
